What is a minor?:
A minor in college often complements a major and allows students to explore another area of study.
Example: Major in Psychology and minor in Spanish

1. Explore Minors on Undergraduate Bulletin according to admission year

2. Consult with your primary advisor, success coach, and the minor faculty chair about adding minor to degree plan to make an informed decision.

3. Use U Achieve to confirm you have sufficient electives to add a minor.

4. To add a minor, follow the steps of your college (i.e. College of Music and Media, College of Arts and Sciences, College of Business, and College of Nursing and Health) by contacting the Dean's office.
